

Example

Look at the table.

Minutes of Homework		
Teacher	Thursday	Friday
Mr. Paola	17	11
Mr. McDougal	11	7
Mr. Gutierrez	6	17
Mrs. Riley	20	19
Miss White	14	19

On Thursday, how much more homework did Mr. Paola assign than Mr. Gutierrez?

Mr. Paola assigned 17 minutes of homework. Mr. Gutierrez assigned 6 minutes of homework. So, Mr. Paola assigned $17 - 6 = 11$ more minutes of homework.

Similarly, Mrs. Riley and Miss White assigned same amount of time for homework on Friday. i.e. 19
